We are very excited to pursue the opportunity of a collaborative effort of Junior Achievement of Georgia and the Savannah Logistics Technology Corridor. Junior Achievement of Georgia has operated in Savannah for 30 years and we have served financial literacy programs to over 100,000 students in the Coastal Georgia region in the last decade. Last year, we served over 17,000 students in Chatham, Effingham, Wayne and Bryan counties.

Our areas of focus are on high impact programs that drive long-term outcomes in areas of **financial literacy, career readiness and fostering the entrepreneurial spirit.**

Youth Development


JA partners with the corporate and civic communities to ensure a collaborative investment in our youth, giving students access to professional possibilities while boosting confidence and skills.

Our capstone program is called the JA Discovery Center. We currently have three in Georgia, one in the World Congress Center in Atlanta, one in Gwinnett, and one in Forsyth County. We are currently involved in site selection for a JA Discovery Center in Savannah. The Savannah Discovery Center would serve at least 8 surrounding counties (17,000 students annually), making this a major impact to financial literacy, entrepreneurship, and career readiness education in the Coastal Region.

We are looking for about 20,000 – 25,000 square feet of open space that could house the 18 storefronts plus offices and meeting space which make up the Discovery Center. Junior Achievement would work with corporate and individual donors for buildout costs and operational costs of the Discovery Center.

We are very interested in partnering with the Savannah Logistics Technology Corridor in this endeavor as we feel like it would be a brilliant collaboration of space and the shared vision of the entrepreneurial spirit of our region.
